Introduction

Main Idea: Christians must not drift away but devote themselves to this great salvation.

I. The Peril of Drifting (v. 1)

- Drifting from the Word
- Duty to Hold Fast

II. The Principle of Discipline (v. 2)

- The Law delivered by angels (Acts 7:38; Galatians 3:19)
- The Law demanded accountability

III. The Problem of Neglect (v. 3a)

- A Great Salvation Despised
- A Great Question Demanded: "How shall we escape...?"

IV. The Proof of Salvation (vv. 3b–4)

- Spoken by the Son
- Shared by the Servants (Eyewitnesses)
- Sealed by the Signs (God's Witness: miracles, gifts of the Spirit)

3. Take Sin and Disobedience Seriously
4. Stop Treating Salvation as Optional or Ordinary
5. Renew Confidence in the Gospel's Reliability
